## **Community Foundation will:**

- 1. Raise funds and invest in organizations that help people, especially those that assist vulnerable populations with senior services, early childhood development, health, homelessness, addiction recovery, mental health, education, and other issues that improve quality of life.
- 2. Support non-profit organizations that strengthen local community.
- 3. Raise awareness with local government officials and broader community (including youth) about UCCF's role by promoting and encouraging local philanthropy through relationship building, networking, speaking engagements, social media, & other outlets.
- 4. Incubate charitable ideas by increasing the number of named funds, increasing discal sponsorships, and encouraging the creation of local nonprofits.
- 5. Work collaboratively with the Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky in the event of a regional disaster to distribute relief funds.

- Invest in 5,000 lives through organizations that serve vulnerable populations, thus enhancing quality of life.
- Increase endowment by 10% annually. Clarify amount needed for endowment to start drawing usable interest.

- Increase the number of named funds and fiscal sponsorships according to capacity.
- Annually review the status of the metrics for success and develop strategic plan as needed.
