Support Arts and Cultural Preservation</b> Revive the John CC Mayo play as a signature fundraiser event to share regional history and support local theater arts. Proceeds benefit the Foundation.</p> <p><b>3. Support education for all ages.</b> Create and grow scholarship funding for college, and start a fund for accessing arts lessons for all ages.</p>	<p><b>Overall Desired Outcomes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New donors will join the Johnson CCF: 10 new donors in year one; 25 new donors in year two; 60 new donors in year three.</li> <li>• Signature event will raise up to \$20,000 per year for the fund.</li> <li>• Generate \$6,600 in 2024 \$15,000 in funding from individual donors to the 264 Club.</li> <li>• Grow 3 scholarship funds within 3 years.</li> <li>• Award 15 stipends in 2024, and 20 stipends in 2025 for people to attend arts classes.</li> </ul>
